- site-specific work

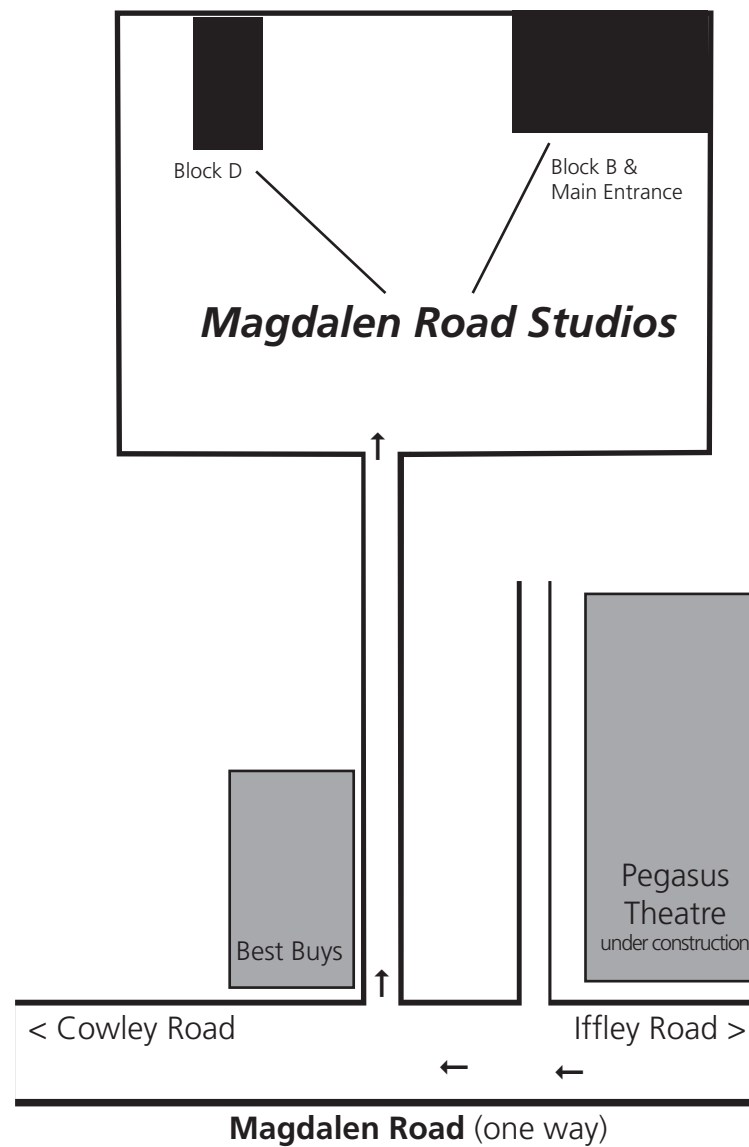
We welcome enquiries from artists looking for studio space. Studio licenses are for one year, renewable annually. Short term lets are sometimes available.
